

3.13 AMENDMENTS TO POLICIES

The Ringette BC Board can amend the operating policies of the Society by regular resolution at any board meeting as set out in the By-laws. Ringette BC staff may edit policies for clarification, consistency, errors and duplication, and these edits to the policy manual will not require a supporting resolution as long as:

- A. The intent of the existing policy is not changed from a common sense perspective;
- B. Correction of grammatical or typographical errors, changed dates (years/season) and other “general housekeeping” do not affect the intent of the policies;
- C. Consolidation of previously approved policy amendments into a new document or section of the document does not alter the meaning of any of the policies; and
- D. Any clarification provided through policy edit, amendment or addition does not disadvantage any Member or group of Members.

Any registered member may also submit recommendations for policy amendment or implementation to the Ringette BC office.
