### Mandate:

The <u>Coach Development Committee</u> is a standing committee of Ringette BC and is mandated to:

- 1. Support volunteer coaches by identifying and communicating the coaching pathways and coach education opportunities offered for all levels of Ringette, including high performance;
- 2. Support coaches by recommending methods to assist in keeping the coach pathway easy to understand and easily accessible:
- 3. Seek identification of coaches to complete high performance training, to enter the mentorship program and to be coach mentors;
- 4. Work in partnership with the Sport and Athlete Development Committee and other relevant committees to ensure suitable coach development for all levels.

## **Committee Composition: Special Skills required for members & Function**

#### Composition:

The committee will be composed of members with experience in coaching ringette and other sports. Representation from each league will be maintained to ensure the varied challenges unique to participation within specific regions are considered. Persons, who are not members of Ringette BC, but with demonstrated coaching experience and knowledge may be appointed to this committee.

#### **Function:**

The majority of the members of the committee will constitute a quorum at any meeting. Motions of the committee including those related to issues such as finalizing publications, reports or recommendations to the Ringette BC Board of Directors are subject to a majority vote of the committee.
