

1.18 ASSOCIATION BOUNDARIES

Association boundaries are to be the same as the city/municipality boundaries. In the event of an association representing more than one city or municipality, the association shall have the same boundaries as the total of those cities or municipalities. Exceptions to these boundaries may be approved from time to time by Ringette BC.

As of September, 2020 association boundaries are set as follows:

FRASER VALLEY	Langley, Township of Langley (including Aldergrove & Fort Langley)	Abbotsford residents may register with Fraser Valley until such time that Chilliwack has established teams in the youth divisions.
