Committee Composition Function

Composition:

The Committee will consist of a five (5) members. The Committee will be chaired by an individual appointed by the Ringette BC Board of Directors. The Committee will include a minimum of two Directors of Ringette BC. Such directors must include at least one outgoing board member and one continuing board member. The remaining committee members should be representative of the Ringette BC membership as much as possible and be as impartial in nature and not conflicted by relations or friendships with current award nominees, and that they are geographically representative of Ringette BC's four leagues.

Function:

The majority of the members of the Committee will constitute a quorum at any meeting. Motions of the committee including those related to issues such as reports or recommendations to the Ringette BC Board of Directors are subject to a majority vote of the committee.
